Junior Netball

Netball is a fun team sport, great for co-ordination and ball skills as well as being fantastic for making new friends. We've had a great start to the 2010 season, with 61 girls from 52 families, making up 7 teams in total.

The girls, primarily from Chatswood, Artarmon, Mowbray and Lane Cove West Primary Schools, and Willoughby High School, form teams within the club, they train every Wednesday night and play in the NSNA competition either Friday or Saturday vs other local Netball teams.

6 games played so far, with 65% success rate across all teams. 1 team (12D) remains unbeaten (good work girls!).

In addition to their Rangers teams, 3 of the girls have been selected for Northern Suburbs Representative Teams, taking part in another game each Saturday, and Sunday carnivals. Well done girls.

Senior Football

The season is fast approaching the halfway mark and despite a few weeks of rain, to date the season has been a remarkable improvement on the past few years.

The Senior Football club continues to grow with the addition of an Over 45 team. This has resulted in 235 players registered which is an increase on last season.

This has also been the most successful start to the season in many years. As outlined in the table below, Rangers have 8 out of the 14 teams in the top 4 with 3 teams leading their competition.

Highlights of the season so far are:

- Premier League has started the season in fine form and are only 3 points off first position. This is a remarkable improvement for our flagship team who are now in strong position to challenge to be the best team in KDSA.
- The All Age 6 team who were new to the club last season are leading their competition and are in a strong position to get promoted this year.
- The Over 35s, led by club President Mike King, are undefeated in first grade and lead the competition already by 7 points.
- Both our Over 45 teams are in a strong position to take out both division titles. The first division team, despite losing their first game in many years, is still very much in contention to repeat their championship victory from last season. The 2nd division team is a fairy tale story. After a tough season last year where they only recorded 2 wins, the team has a 100% record this season leading the competition by a massive 8 points. Congratulations so far to David Holder and the rest of the team.
